**Releasing Informational Video about the Jingu Gaien Redevelopment Project**

Tokyo, Japan, June 30, 2023 – Mitsui Fudosan Co., Ltd., a leading global real estate company headquartered in Tokyo, together with Meiji Jingu, the Japan Sports Council, and ITOCHU Corporation announced today that we will open a page for viewing an informational video and submitting questions about the Jingu Gaien District Urban Redevelopment Project (“the project”) within the website for the project. The project is attracting interest from many people and a variety of feedback and questions. To offer a clearer, more thorough explanation about the project to as many people as possible, we will release an informational video about plan details on the project website.

In addition, we will newly open a page for submitting questions about the project to facilitate response to inquiries. We will post replies to the questions that we receive on the project website at a later date. To address as many questions and concerns as possible, we plan on summarizing the content of inquiries and replying to each topic successively.

Moreover, we will hold briefings for members of the local community covering the same content as in the documents and informational video on the project website. They will be held on July 17 (Monday/national holiday), 18 (Tuesday), and 19 (Wednesday), so we plan to deliver an invitation to the residences, corporate offices, and so forth of the relevant parties. This invitation will be necessary to join a briefing.

We also plan to release information about inquiries made at the briefings on the project website.

Since many people are interested in the project, we also considered holding briefings without restrictions on participation. However, we decided to hold briefings for members of the local community as well as release an informative video and accept and respond to inquiries to clearly and thoroughly address everyone’s concerns and questions.
